

DECLARATION

PERSISTENT, BIOACCUMULATIVE AND TOXIC (PBT) CHEMICALS

As required under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)¹, as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) opened provisions for evaluation and assessment of chemicals that are persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT), and subsequent enforcement of final rules passed to the federal register. Section 6 of TSCA allows for substances to be restricted in all states of the U.S. The TSCA Section 6 restrictions include the substances and groups that have been identified by the EPA as posing unreasonable risk to humans and the environment.

The Rules limit or prohibit the manufacture (including import), processing, and/or distribution in commerce (including within articles) of the following PBT chemicals:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate 3:1 (PIP 3:1)
- 2, 4, 6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2, 4, 6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

Reotemp Instrument Corporation (REOTEMP) certifies that it is compliant with the requirements of TSCA regarding the five (5) PBT chemicals listed above and that none of the above-mentioned chemicals are intentionally used or added to our products.
